



POCKET FAVOR MINI TUTORIAL



Supplies:

Stamps: So Very Grateful

Inks: Black Stazon, Crushed Curry

Markers: Crushed, Wisteria Wonder, Coastal Cabana, Pear Pizzazz

Paper: Afternoon Picnic DSP, Very Vanilla, Crushed Curry

Accessories: Small Oval Punch, Pearls, Scraps of coordinating ribbon and Gold Bakers Twine, Diagonal Scoring Plate for Simply Scored, Stampin' Dimensionals

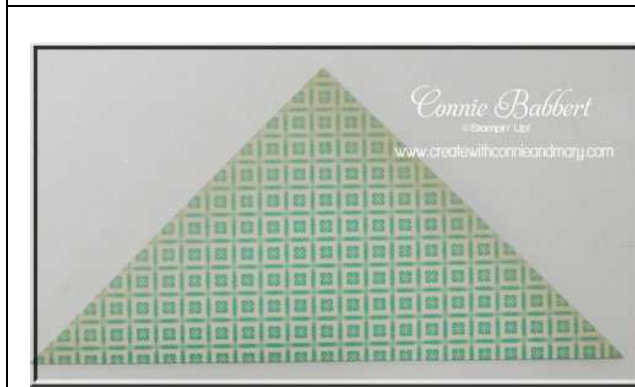


Step 1:

Cut Designer Paper in an 8x8 square.

Score with Diagonal Plate on Simply Scored at 0 Corner and 3/4. Flip to opposite side and score again at 3/4 on other side of 0 line. (You will have 3 lines going in the same direction)

Quarter turn and score at 2 3/4, then flip to other side and score at 2 3/4 again.



Step 2

Fold in half at center 0 score line.

Punch with Small Oval Punch at top point while folded.



Step 3

Open up and fold side flaps in.



Step 4

Crease on middle score lines, you should have a Valley fold, Mountain fold and Valley fold (W) looking from the side. Pockets should be on the outside (bottom).



Step 5

Use scraps of coordinating ribbons and twine to hold closed. Fill with 3x3 note card, candy or other small items.

Decorate. I used the 1 1/4 Circle of Designer Paper and Crushed Curry Scallop Circle for the front. Stamped the greeting with Black Stazon and cut flag ends, then added to circles.



Step 6

3x3 card:

Fold 3 x 6 Very Vanilla in half, add 2 3/4 x 2 3/4 Designer Paper to front. Stamp flower image with Black Stazon on scrap Very Vanilla, color with Markers and cut out. Place on front of note card. Add greeting stamped with Crushed Curry and cut out.

Candy wrapper:

Measure size of candy and wrap DSP around. Stamp the Very Grateful flowers on scrap Very Vanilla with Black Stazon, cut out a portion and adhere on front.
